## Why do Catholics do that??

### Facts about Ash Wednesday (February 18, 2026)

- Ash Wednesday marks the beginning of Lent.
- We receive ashes on our foreheads with the words "Remember you are dust, and to dust you shall return" or "Turn away from sin and be faithful to the Gospel."
- ANYONE can receive ashes – you don't have to be Catholic
- Ashes are made from last year's Palm Sunday palms
- The ashes symbolize our mortality and ongoing need for repentance and redemption through Christ's Passion.
- For Catholics Ash Wednesday is a day of fasting and abstinence. (No meat or between meal snacks and only one large meal and two smaller meals that would not add up to a full meal)
