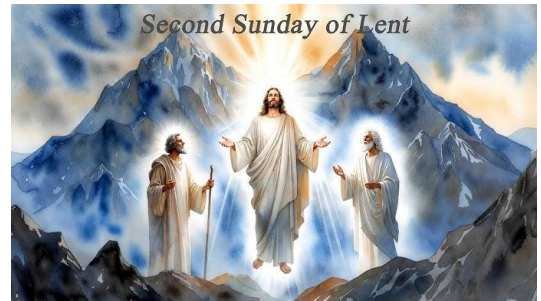

What is Proper Mass Etiquette?

Mass is the highest form of sacrifice we can offer, therefore we should prepare and engage ourselves accordingly. These are some basic Do's and Don'ts when attending Mass.

- **DO: Fast** from any food or drink at least an hour before receiving communion.
- **DO: Dress appropriately** to show decency and honor to God.
- **DON'T use your phone** during Mass and if you have it make sure it is on silent.
- **DO Genuflect** by kneeling on one knee in the direction of the tabernacle before sitting.
- **DO Participate** by singing, responding, listening, and praying.
- **DO Examine your conscience** before receiving the Eucharist.
- **DO Be Still** - Don't be in a hurry. Feel God's presence and take time to thank Him.
